An Overview

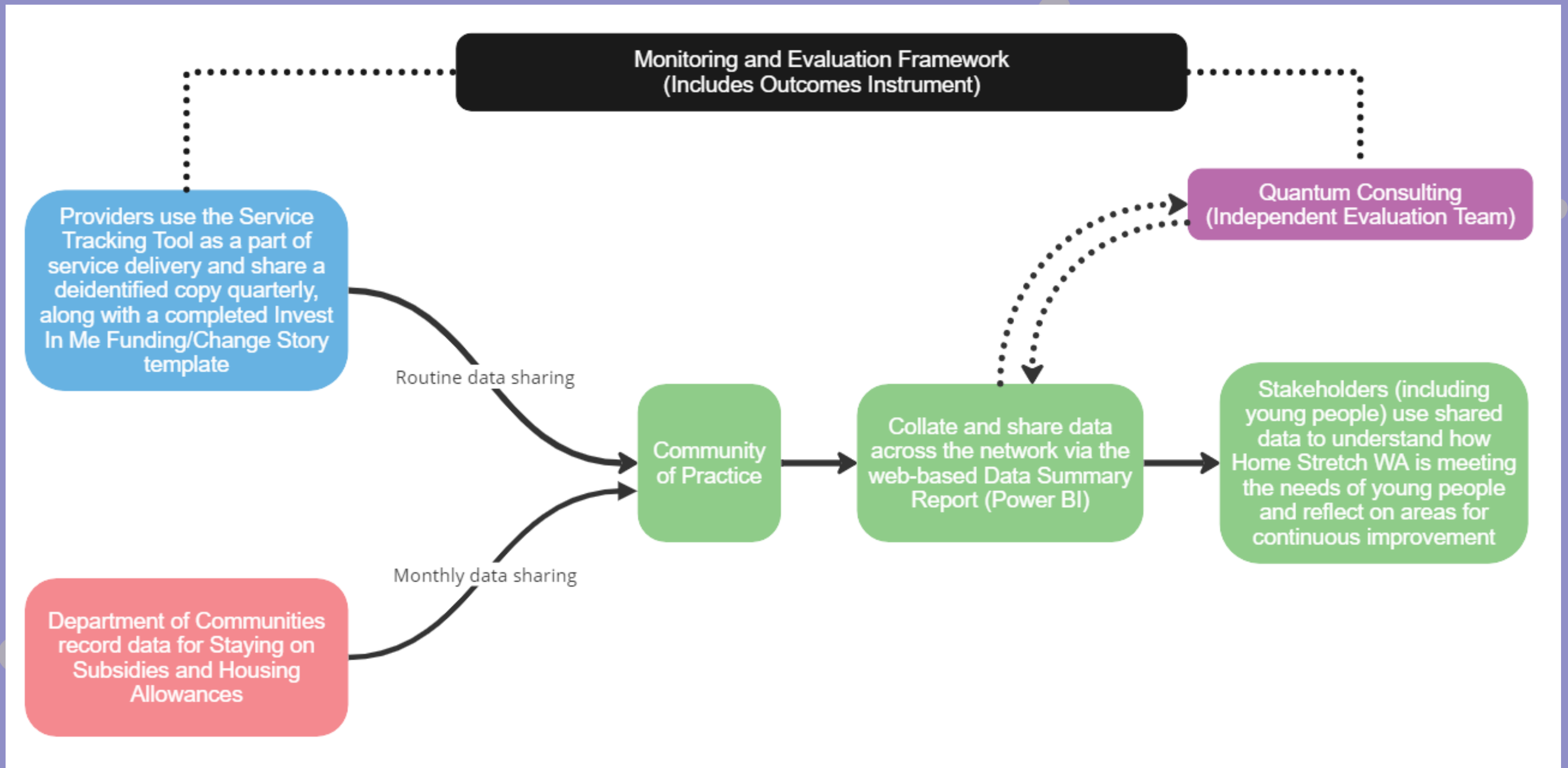
Key functions of the Community of Practice (CoP) are to support and facilitate shared outcomes, monitor data, and evaluate the program across providers and regions where Home Stretch WA services are offered.

Providers will contribute data about their Home Stretch WA service to

- Department of Communities (the Department),
- Community of Practice backbone team (Anglicare WA)
- Quantum Consulting (external evaluators).

Data sharing is a contractual agreement between providers and the Department.

The Big Picture



Privacy & Confidentiality

Longitudinal data is paramount to the Home Stretch WA program to capture individual outcomes experienced by young people and measure changes related to the program.

To meet privacy requirements, the creation of Unique Identifiers (UI) is needed to track progress for each young person, while ensuring that any data for that person remains non-identifiable by a third party. Providers will construct the UI using a combination of a person's name and month of birth. The following stepped example illustrates how to develop a UI for the fictional young person named 'Graham Jones', who was born in August:

- 1. Use the first three letters of the person's last name – 'JON'**
- 2. The first three letters of the person's first name – 'GRA' and**
- 3. The person's birth month (include zero for single digit months) – August**

The fictional young person's UI would become 'JONGRA08' i.e., every UI should include 6 letters and 2 numbers (8 characters)

The UI (rather than first and last name) will be used for all monitoring and evaluation information collected through the CoP, as well as through the external evaluation, such as interview data with young people.

All information shared with the CoP is governed by a Data Sharing and Privacy Agreement, developed between the Department of Communities, Anglicare WA and each commissioned provider. All data held by Anglicare WA is recorded and stored in line with the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1988, and Anglicare WA's Privacy and Client Records policies.

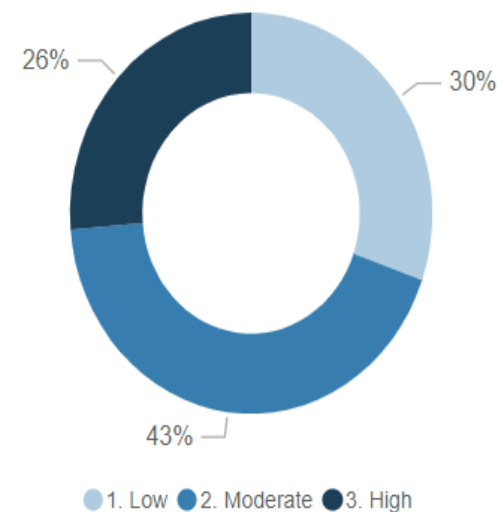
Examples include demographics of young people referred and onboarded, service engagement, Invest In Me Funding expenditure, Staying On Subsidies and Housing Allowance.

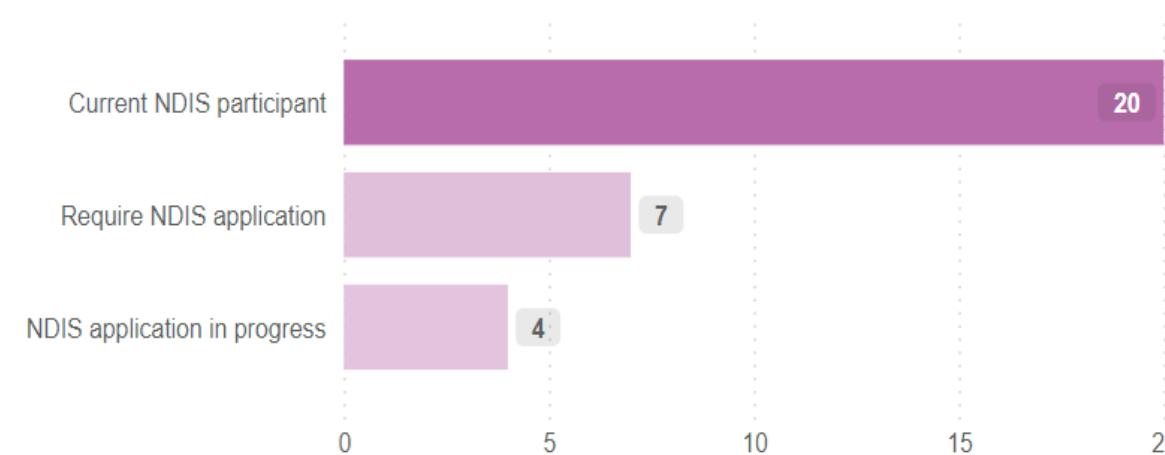

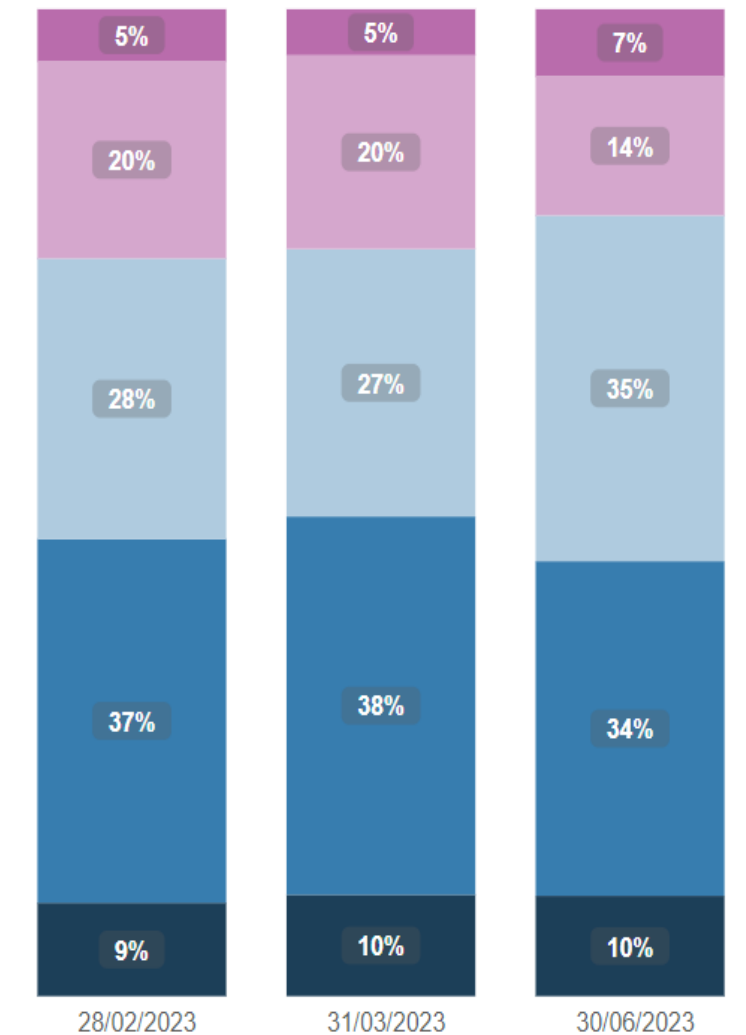


Onboarded Young People with Disability

Service Tracking Tool

The Service Tracking Tool (STT) is an Excel spreadsheet developed between the CoP and Home Stretch WA providers to assist providers to run a comprehensive service and capture the agreed minimum data set of the statewide program.

The STT will enable providers to track and monitor a young person's journey from referral through the various program elements. It includes formulas and functions to reduce administrative burden and support providers to build confidence using data to guide and improve service delivery.

Providers populate the tool using information about young people and share a copy of the deidentified tool with the CoP quarterly. Providers may opt to not use the entire tool; however, the 1. Referral and Intake and 2. Transition Coach tabs are required along with the separate Invest In Me Funding (IIMF) and Change Story template.

This information will contribute to broader systems improvement, provide insight into service statistics, trends, opportunities, and risks. It is a critical element of evaluating the success of Home Stretch in WA.

If useful, the CoP will offer additional support for providers to understand and use this information within a Results Based Accountability (RBA) framework to drive continuous improvement. RBA is a simple, data-driven outcome measurement framework that enables services to measure their impact by gathering data to answer three fundamental questions:

1. How much have we done?
2. How well have we done it?
3. Is anyone better off?

4. **Staying On Subsidies**
5. **Housing Allowance**



The Best Way to Share Data

- Always ensure to **remove the first name and surname** of young people from within **ALL the tabs** of the Service Tracking Tool
- Emails are not a safe way to share information within the Service Tracking Tool
- The CoP will provide the nominated data person for each provider with a secure link to a file located on the Anglicare WA SharePoint site
- Each provider will upload the files required for that data sharing date to the designated file instead of emailing
- The CoP can offer extra support if needed
